



## REGULATION OF REPETITION AND COMPENSATION

In general, the regulations of the university that is in charge of a course according to the module descriptions have to be applied for this course. "Examination procedure and regulations including examination language can be further regulated by individual exam regulations of each partner university and together with each teacher" (Joint Study Regulations §11).

For courses given at Rheinland-Pfälzische Technische Universität Kaiserslautern-Landau the regulations of Saarland University apply.

The courses "Introduction to Border Studies from a cultural studies approach" (Module 3) and "Dealing with knowledge in multilingual contexts" (Module 6) are treated as courses of University of Luxembourg.

## REPETITION OF EXAMS

According to the Joint Study Regulations § 14 "Possibilities and conditions for the repetition of exams and/or Master Thesis can be further regulated by the local exam regulations of the partner universities."

That means that the possibility to repeat an exam depends on the regulations of the university that is in charge of the course according to the module descriptions.

The possibility to repeat the Master Thesis depends on the regulations of the university of the first supervisor.

**Table 1: Repetition of exams**

University in charge*	Possibilities and conditions for repetition
UdS	No possibility to repeat a passed exam to improve the mark; If an exam is not passed it may be repeated two times (in exceptional cases it may be repeated three times); If an exam is definitely not passed there is no possibility to repeat the course. Master thesis: If the Master thesis is not passed it may be repeated once ("Freiversuch-Regelung" if the master thesis is handed in in the standard period of study)
ULor	Pas de rattrapage. Il y a une compensation à l'année pour les UE de l'ULor <b>sauf</b> pour le stage. Il faut une note minimum de 10/20 au stage.
ULu	<u>For students beginning the programme in 2017:</u> If an exam is not passed it may be repeated as long as the student is allowed to study. For a full time student 6 semesters are the maximum on which he can study, if after the 6 semesters the student was not able to pass the exams it is definitely not possible to pass the exam.  <u>For students beginning the programme in 2018 and later:</u> If an exam is not passed it may be repeated four times. If then the exam is definitely not passed there is no possibility to repeat the course. If a student failed one exam, he has 21 days to tell the course director that he wants to repeat the exam. If a student became a 10/20 or a 12/20 but he wants to obtain a 16/20 he has 21 days to tell the course director that he want to repeat the exam. Both examples can be done 4 times. The last note who the student received will always be the note which will be written on his grade transcript.  (Students in Luxembourg can just pass in the next study year if they received 70 % of the ECTS)

**COMPENSATION**

**Inter-module compensation**

There is no possibility to compensate between different modules. That means that every module has to be passed.

**Intra-module compensation**

The possibility to compensate within one module depends on the regulations of the university that is in charge of the module.
